Instructions for Completing the Architectural Request Form for Painting a Home.

Download and complete the Architectural Request form. In addition to the information requested on the form, each request must include the following:

- Six paint chips for each color to be used. Each chip must be at a minimum 1.5" square (1.5" by 1.5").
- An artist rendering of how you intend to apply the color scheme.

The Architectural Board must take into consideration all aspects of your color choice, so the better detailed your request is, the easier it will be for the board to issue a prompt decision.

Homeowners are encouraged to paint a sample of their color choices in an inconspicuous location on a back or side wall that is not visible to the general public. Many homeowners have requested and received approval, only to come back to us because once applied on a large spot and viewed in the sunlight, the color didn't look the same as the color on the chip. Sadly a few have paid a professional to do the work only to be unhappy for the same reason.

The last page of this document is a sample of a rendering The sample was created by taking a picture of the subject home, lightening the contrast and printing it in black and white. Then a simple addition of colors to define the areas for each painted color.

Please Note that these requests MUST be mailed or hand delivered to the management company.

Email or fax requests will be declined upon receipt. Original paint chips are required. This is because scanned colors do not render correctly.


